CapMetro/City of Austin ILA: Citywide Light Fund\$ = \$7.1B Project Connect/rail South/West/Central whites (45th/Red River)

KVUE (2017): 75 people hit in 3 miles, NLTC to Payton Gin. = "Dangerous by Design" (poor, minority, non-English ~Joel Meyer)

TxDOT (2015-20): Loop 275, US 183-Howard ~37,500 vpd, \$482M (3,900 crashes; 380 pedestrian deaths: midblock) ~CEO Dottie Watkins
